



## **HIKING** IN THE SUMMERTIME

Whoever hikes in Val Casies Valley, gets closer and closer to nature - you will feel it! On easy and more difficult paths, passing traditional huts and further to amazing mountain summits. Spectacular views of majestic mountains of the Dolomites, Unesco World Heritage. Thanks to the versatility of the area there are many, familyfriendly excursions and tours available. Walking on the path "Almweg 2000", where many huts are reachable, you can enjoy breathtaking views into and outward the vallev.

There are also many themend paths: "Via Lucis", the first path for meditation in South Tyrol, which shows pictures of Easter and Pentecost along the way. A unique familyfriendly excursion would be the "Sagenweg": in wood carved figures are lurking behind every corner and tell fairytales. On the "Ochsenweg" you will find out details of the famous oxen of Val Casies Valley.

#### THE PATHS ACROSS THE COLS!

Three cross-border themed paths with different topics lead from Val Casies Valley-Monguelfo-Tesido to Villgratental Valley



#### THE CULTIVATING PATH

Even though technology got more modern and machines help to ease work, farmers from Val Casies Valley and Villgratental Valley keep doing their work similair to the way they did it 100 years ago.

Directions: Starting point in S. Maddalena/ Val Vasies Valley and walking through Pfoital Valley until Gsieser Lenke further to lake Schwarzsee and Unterstalleralm hut. It is also possible to walk it the opposite way!

#### THE SMUGGLERS' PATH

After the 1st world war, according to the contract of Saint Germain, South Tyrol became part of Italy. That is how a border emerged between Val Casies Valley and Villgraten Valley. Across that border smugglers brought goods like sugar, coffee, tobacco, petrol and cigarette lighters from Austria to Italy.

Directions: Starting point at the hut by the end of the valley "Talschlusshütte" in S. Maddalena/ Val Casies Valley taking the path with number 48 to reach the Tscharniet Alm hut (1976m) and further to "Kalksteinjöchl" (2349m). Descent on the smuggler's path (13a) through the Valley Rosstal past the Oberlipper Alm hut and finally to Kalkstein. It is also possible to walk it the opposite way!

#### THE TRADITIONS AND CUSTOMS PATH

How are butter and cheese even made? What kind of festivity is "Kirchtag" and how is it celebrated? What are healing herbs and where are they to be found? - This educational trail will teach its visitors all those things.

Directions: Starting point in S. Martino/ Val Casies Valley on the path that leads through Verselltal Valley to Gruber Lenke until Alfenalm hut and Kalkstein. It is also possible to walk it the opposite way!

HIKER'S BUS This bus brings the hikers from Villgratental Valley (AT) back to Val Casies Valley from Monday to Friday in July, August and September.



#### PATH OF THE OXEN

#### Circuit at the end of Val Casies Valley about the oxen of Val Casies Valley.

Follow the tracks of the "Gsieser Almochsen" - Val Casies Valley Oxen: the circular hike starts at the end of the valley in St. Magdalena, leads along the "Talblickweg" and passes the adventure farm Reierhof, the fruit farm Regionof and the diary factory Waldsamerhof. On the way some surprises expect you.

Beneficial effects: the Gsieser oxen weighed about 700 kilograms were distinguished by their special mast. For two summers, the animals, under the care of their shepherds, are taken to the native pastures, where they get the juicy feeds and herbs to eat.

#### TRAIL OF LEGENDS IN TESIDO

#### Mystic encounters along the trail of legends.

- 4 legends from the area around Tesido are represented along the Trail of Legends. Immerse yourself in the myths and legends on the 3 km long round trail.
- parking place in the Via Riva di Sotto, 100 meters above the parish church at Tesido/Taisten.

#### "VIA LUCIS"

South Tyrol's first "Way of Light" in S. Martino/Val Casies Valley. The Way of Light (Via Lucis) celebrates the most joyful time in the Christian liturgical year, the fifty days from Easter (the resurrection) to Pentecost (descent of the Holy

Along the trail you will find spiritual paintings from the local artist Lukas Kargruber.

- Parish church in S. Martino/Gsieser Tal Valley. Destination: Breitgisse. Back via Karbach Valley.
- ½ 2 hours, drop: 200 m

These trails will bring joy to everyone who is excited about special adventures in nature – unforgettable moments are assured.



#### **SCHNEIDER WALDILE**

#### Val Casies Valley/ Colle-Planca di Sotto-Puregg (1.260 m)

"Feel the freedom with bare feet..." Have a break at the Kneipp facility and enjoy the refreshing experience. By wating through the cooling water you'll do something good for your health. The facility is suitable for young and old and offers the possibility to make this extraordinary experience: waking barefooted through the water, walking over meadows and bathing your arms and feet as well.



#### PYRAMID KNEIPP PATH "RUDLBACH" parking area of Prati di Tesido (1400m).

By keeping the saying "naturally healthy" in mind, the barefoot path in Tesido was built. The single stops along this path offer relaxation and recovery. You will never forget this unusual experience full of joy and fun. By walking over wooden bridges, small stones and forest floors, and by dipping your feet into the cool stream, you can feel the nature. Get out of your socks and jump into the fresh water!

#### "HOT SPOTS"

These are places you MUST SEE! Go on a little journey in the Dolomites, which are part of the UNESCO world heritage, because of their breathtaking beauty.



#### THREE-HUT-EXCURSION FROM SESTO TO THREE PEAKS

Adventurous hike through the valley Altensteintal passing the Tre Cime.

Hardly any excursion is more breathtaking. The amazing trail leads from hut Zsigmondihütte to hut Dreizinnenhütte, which offers the popular view of the northern side of the Tre Cime. Halfway through there is a hut named Büllelejochhütte where there is a refreshment possibilitiy.

#### Circular walk around Lake Braies in Braies Valley

#### HIGH PLATEAU PRATO PIAZZA

#### in Braies Valley

This beautiful place has an altitude of 2000 meters and offers incredible views of the surrounding mountains named Dürrenstein, Hohe Gaisl, Monte Christallo and Tofane.

A beautiful lake at the end of Valley Anterselva. A renewed nature-adventure-path leads around the 35 meters deep lake.

## HIKING IN THE WINTERTIME

#### SKI TOUR TO "HOHER MANN"

From the head of the valley in St. Magdalena in the Gsieser Valley 1.465 m, follow the piste uphill on its edge to the alpine path number 10 "Ascht". Now continue on a wide forest road through the woods covered in deep snow all the way to the Aschtalm at 1.950 m (rest point). Then proceed westwards on the alpine path to the Pfinnalm at 2.152 m and to the Pfinnscharte (notch) at 2.395 m. Please consider the avalanche risk: only descend the slope if the covering of snow is stable! In another 30 minutes reach the Hoher Mann at 2.539 m, over the steep ridge. The impressive panoramic view rewards your efforts. Now look forward to a fantastic downhill run! As the touring map explains, you can also climb on the orographic left side of the stream from the Aschtalm, traverse clear mountain woods and wide alpine terrain and hike past many hay barns of the Pfinnalm towards Hoher Mann. At the notch, at an altitude of 2.499 m, keep left and climb the Hoher Mann over the "Nord Grat" (northern ridge). Snowshoe hikers: As explained previously, keep to the forest path number 10 all the way to the Pfinnalm 2.152 m. From there, reach the Pfinnscharte (notch) at 2.359 m in just 45 minutes by climbing up steeply along the basin of the valley.

#### **SNOWSHOE TOUR TO "LUTTERKOPF"** AND "DURRAKOP"

From the tourist office in Tesido 1.203 m, turn left at the gothic piety column and pass the parish church in the direction of the Hotel Alpen Tesitin. Turn right onto the Guggenberg and follow the forest road to the next crossing. Please note: take a left there and after a tight right corner and another 300 m reach the starting point of your route at the large parking area. There, at 1.590 m the forest path numbered 31 diverts on your left in a westerly direction. After the first bend take the steep and bumpy path on your left, leading you directly to the higher situated forest road. Cross it and walk leisurely uphill by paying attention to the red-white markings and number 31. The landscape visibly becomes more fascinating as you cross the terrain at an altitude of 2.000 m above sea level. In the distance, catch sight of the summit cross of the Lutterkopf 2.145 m, surrounded by magnificent mountain scenery. The tour continues northwards across open alpine terrain. Always along the ridge and after a considerable hike reach a fence with an opening, taking you directly down to the Taistner Vorderalm. At this point, however, continue to your second destination, namely the Durakopf at 2.275 m. From its summit, go down eastwards to the Klenkboden at 2186 m and then southwards across a vast mountain pasture to the Taistner Vorderalm at 2.012 m (rest point). From here, return to the starting point Mudler Hof (rest point) in just 1 1/2 hours on foot or much faster by tobogganing.

- parking area above the mountain restaurant Mudler Hof in Tesido 1.584 m
- to ca. 3 hours 3 hours/30 min., drop: ca. 700 m



#### HIKE TO CASTLE WELSPERG

From the bus stop in "Via Stazione" at 1087 m, proceed through the village centre, pass the bandstand in the main square on your right side and carry on straight to the bridge over the Gsieser Stream. There, in an easterly direction follow the signs for the "Grosse Schlossrunde" (long Castle Walk) on the old Gsieser Road. After about 50 minutes turn right over a narrow wooden bridge and continue left on the other side. After a short climb along a wide bend and through meadows, continue all the way to the forest where you find the old Castle Walk. Now proceed downhill out of the valley through woods past Welsperg Castle, the "Paul Troger" memorial park and the secondary school all the way back to the starting point.

- 100 m 2 hours, drop: 100 m





## **CYCLING**

Whoever wants to get to know the history of all the little towns, of the citizens and of the impressive and intact nature, should do it by bike! There are no major drops and the panorama constantly changes. The roads are ideal for beginners and families. In Monguelfo you can access to the cycling path of Valpusteria Valley towards Brunico or Lienz (AT). So hop on your bicycle and right into the Valley!

#### CYCLING ROUTE FROM MONGUELFO TO VAL CASIES VALLEY

Following partly the old Val Casies Valley road and partly access roads to farms, the route takes you from Monguelfo to Planca di Sotto, where you cross the river and follow the road again. In Prateria you cross the main street and follow the cycling route to chapel "Maria Heimsuchung". From S. Martino you follow again the old Val Casies Valley road until you reach the head of the valley in S. Maddalena. From there you return to Monguelfo at the same route.

- Monguelfo village centre
- Drop: 372 m, distance: 18,4 km



#### CYCLING ROUTE FROM MONGUELFO TO BRUNICO

Along the train rails on uphill and downhill from town to town until Brunico. Cycling through nature until you reach the small city Brunico where many shops and a beautiful castle await you. If you are tired you can easily use the train for free (using your guestpass) for returning to Monguelfo and leave the bike at the rental station (Papin-Rent a Bike). Just make sure to buy a ticket for your bike.

Drop: 249 m, distance: 16 km



#### CYCLING ROUTE FROM MONGUELFO TO LIENZ (A)

This road is one of the most loved ones in Alto Adige: the transboundary track to Lienz. It is suitable for every kind of bike and for adults as well as for children. Everybody can cycle the 55 km without a huge effort and for the return you can use the train for free (using your guestpass) and leave the bike at the rental station (Papin - Rent a Bike) in Lienz. From Lienz to S. Candido you need to buy a ticket for you and for your bike. From S. Candido to Monguelfo you just need a ticket for your bike. The small city offers many shops and nice restaurants.

Drop: 530 m, distance: 55 km

#### PROCEDURE FOR THE TRANSPORT OF DOGS AND OTHER ANIMALS:

Guide dogs and small animals are carried free of charge if being carried in one's arms or within a cage or container with a maximum size of 70x30x50 cm. Other animals can travel or with a single ticket: 15 cents per chilometer or with the Mobilcard Junior (1, 3 or 7 days).
